

Dispose of your BBQ safely

Disposable barbecues, when used carelessly, can set dry grass alight and damage the surfaces they are put on, including picnic tables and benches.



Check whether there are permanent barbecue pits or areas. If you do take your own disposable barbecue with you please follow these few guidelines:

- ⇒ Do not put directly on the grass or close to dry vegetation.
- ⇒ Set up on the wet sand or raise up on stones.
- ⇒ Douse the barbecue with cold water to cool the ash. The foil of the barbecue may remain very hot.
- ⇒ Ensure you dispose of your barbecue responsibly either by taking it home or putting it in the bin. Remember to make sure the barbecue is COLD before putting it in the bin as many bins are plastic and could melt.
